<u>Proposed Fiscal Year 2024-2025 LAFCO Budget:</u> The Commission will make a proposed determination thereon for the 2024-2025 LAFCO budget. Any person may be heard regarding the increase, decrease, addition or omission to the proposed budget.

<u>LAFCO File 2023-0004/RD784 Annexation</u>: A request from Reclamation District 784 for a Sphere of Influence amendment and annexation of approximately 703.4 acres into their district. Said project would annex the existing levees and give access to the footprint of the entire Urban Levee System, located within Yuba County.

Persons may attend and be heard at the time and place of the hearing. If you challenge the action of the Commission on any of the above stated item in court, it may be limited to only those issues raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Yuba Local Agency Formation Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing.

The Commission will consider oral and written testimony by any interested person or affected agency as well as the report of the Executive Officer. At the hearing, the Commission may approve or disapprove a proposal with or without amendment, wholly, partially, or conditionally, <u>may include or exclude territory in this change of organization</u> or may continue its consideration with or without amendment, as a whole, in part, or upon such conditions as the Commission may determine. The extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by a local agency or a successor local agency may be applied in the affected territory. The Commission may waive protest and election proceedings if no written protests or objections are raised at this hearing by persons either owning land within the subject territory or, in the case, the territory is inhabited, by anyone registered to vote who is currently residing within the annexation territory.
